INTRO

Lane Cove Tennis Club is offering 4 young tennis players financial assistance for a year as part of the Jack Frazer Memorial Scholarship program.

The scholarship is to the value of:

\$2,500 per person

The Scholarships are open to young players aged 12 to 18 years who have ambitions to play at a premier grade, elite competition or tournament level.

Players will be: hardworking, sportsperson-like, still at school or first year university or TAFE or gap year, a team player (or have a desire to learn team skills), willing to train at and represent Lane Cove Tennis Club, and keen to learn from some 'handy' and experienced players at the Club. And they must be committed to improving their rating/ranking.

The financial support will cover such expenses as: tournament fees, coaching fees, travel and accommodation associated with competition or tournament play, fitness training.

Each player and their parent/coach will agree with the Scholarship Advisory Committee the mix of expenses to be covered by the Scholarship funds.



ELIGIBILITY & VALUE

Criteria

- Young tennis players aged 12 to 18 years in the calendar year
- Australian citizen
- Reside in on Sydney's North Shore (ie LGAs – North Sydney, Mosman, Lane Cove, Willoughby, Ku-ring-gai, Hunters Hill)
- A competition and/or tournament player, including NSTA
- Demonstrated attributes of being hardworking, competitive, sportsperson-like, enjoying playing tennis, self-motivated, and friendly

Those on Scholarship will be required to:

1. Represent and play for Lane Cove Tennis Club in at least three (3) TA and TNSW accredited tournaments and competitions
2. Represent and play for Lane Cove in at least two (2) NTSA or TNSW competitions (weekends)
3. Practice at Lane Cove Tennis Club at least twice a week with others on Scholarship, your coach or hitting partner
4. Be available to attend and play in at least two (2) Club social tennis events (Wimbledon Day, Garry Butler Shield) or attendance at Saturday social
5. Provide a written report to the Scholarship Advisory Committee on a quarterly basis on use of funds, achievements and areas of focus

Value

Four 12-month Scholarships worth \$2,500 each for 4 different junior players.

Lane Cove Tennis Club

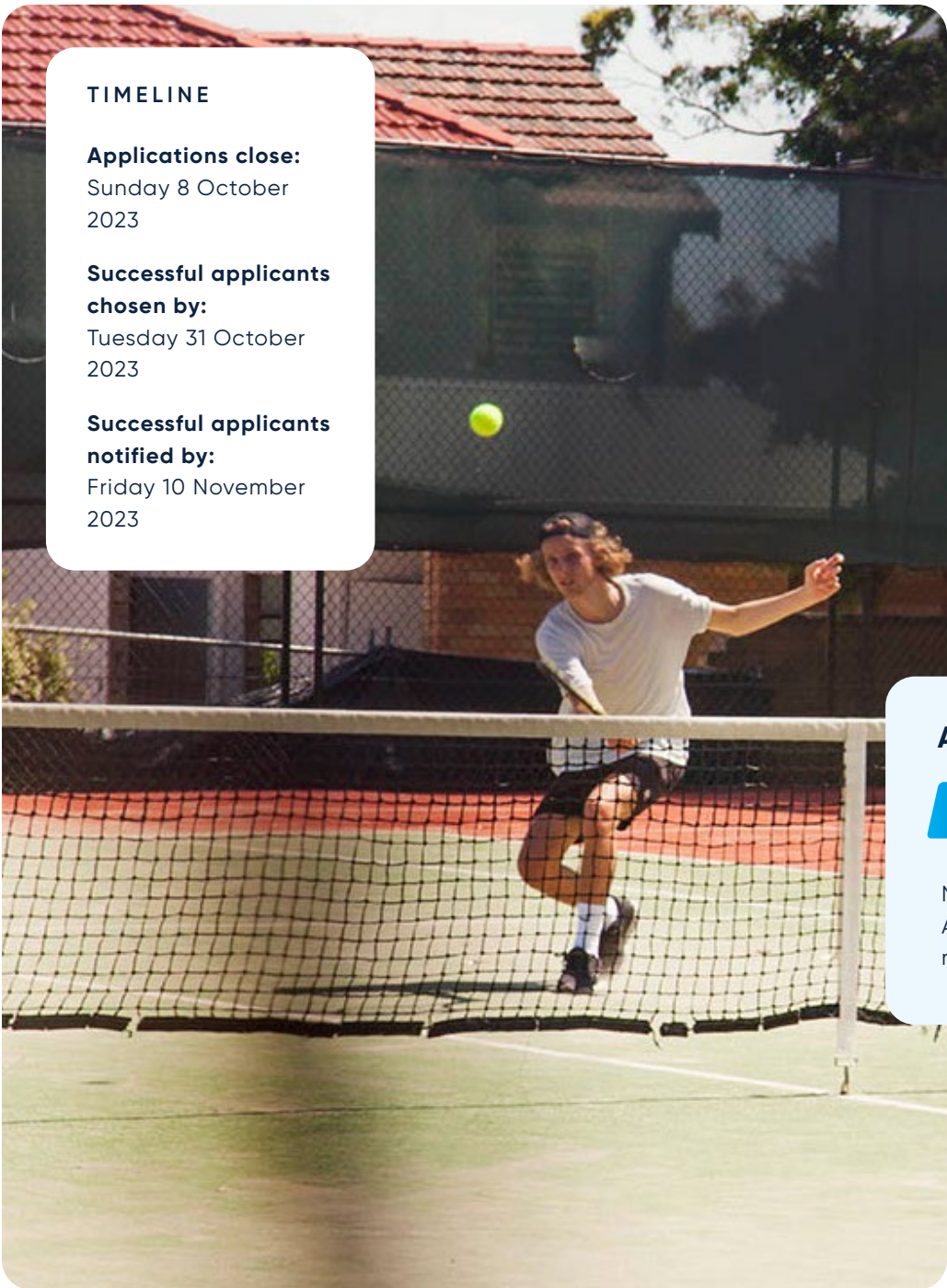

Application requirements

All applications are to be submitted online and comprise:

- Player resume – profile, list of current playing activities and achievements (tournament/competitions played, results, ranking improvements)
- Player statement (written by the player) – description of who you are, activities and achievements other than tennis, what is important to you, your goals over the next 12 months, why you should be awarded a scholarship (between 300 and 500 words maximum)
- Referee (ie coach, school teacher or others in the community)
- Photograph (minimum 1)

All applications will be assessed by the Scholarship Advisory Committee.

Applications close

Sunday 8 October 2023

No applications will be considered after the close date. The Scholarship Advisory Committee's decision is final. Successful applicants will be notified in mid-September and be required to meet to agree on Scholarship requirements.
